PROSPECT strengthens the capacity of European local and regional authorities and their agencies to implement sustainable energy and climate actions by **using innovative financing schemes** and therefore reducing reliance on public funding.

The project offers a **peer-to-peer capacity-building programme** tailored to the needs and time constraints of public authorities, available in multiple languages and structured in adaptable learning modules.

Through large-scale outreach, including very small and remote municipalities, PROSPECT acts as an **entry point to EU programmes** and **financing opportunities** for authorities seeking to strengthen their experience with innovative financing instruments.

The Capacity-Building Programme

Our three level approach ensures that participants can learn at their own pace and advance according to their expertise, needs and project maturity.

Participants

Participants can be representatives from LRAs and their agencies from all over the EU and other eligible countries.

Mentors will showcase their experience in leading successful sustainable energy and climate projects.

Mentees will explore innovative financing schemes that help implement energy and climate actions in their cities and regions.

Level 1: PROSPECT Community

Offers access to learning resources and introduces participants to financing schemes enabling assessment prior to more personalised learning pathways.

Open to everyone upon registration to the PROSPECT Academy!



Level 2: PROSPECT Peer-learning Programme - Steps

This level is open to **representatives from LRAs**, and their agencies with the direct support of the Mayor or their Director seeking to further progress in their learning journey.



01 Online meeting

Participants meet each other, present their project ideas and their objectives for the study visit.



02 Study visit

A 1.5-day study visit to the mentor's premises, including an in-depth workshop on the mentor's project and financing scheme.



03 Online meeting

An online meeting one month after the study-visit, where the mentor follows up with the mentees on the status of the implementation of the project.



04 Masterclass (optional)

2 Masterclasses in Brussels offering cross-cycle networking & expert insights into financing opportunities. Participation is by selection, based on the participants' engagement in the programme and project progress.

Level 3: PROSPECT Advanced Mentoring

Mentees with advanced projects, completed transferability analysis, and experience with at least one PROSPECT tool will have the opportunity for advanced mentoring.

This phase includes **two tailored 2-hour bilateral sessions** with the mentor, involving relevant LRA staff or elected officials.
