

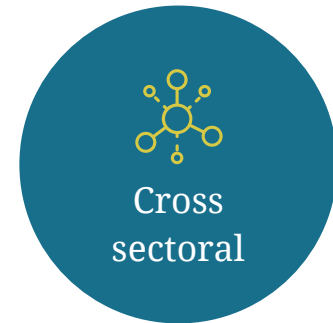


Implementation of Energy Saving Funds in the French Region Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes

Energy Saving Funds in the French Region Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes

In France, many local authorities suffer a lack of expertise and/or financial capacities when it comes to financing energy transition measures. This collective training helps mentees prepare and implement their own energy saving funds ("intracting" funds), based on the model of a local "great witness": Albertville. Over the four training sessions, the mentees can explore and question each of the fundamental aspects of this scheme: strategy, organization, finance and technical implementation.



Challenges

- Some of the mentees need individual support to answer specific situations (hospitals).
- When managers and/or elected officials do not involve themselves, there is a great risk of incompleteness.



Successes for Replicability

- The collective framework seems to be well appreciated.
- AURAE produced an intracting toolbox, now available online.
- In many cases, the training initiated a dynamic of common work between financial and technical services.
